

# **Freshman/Sophomore Day at Cedar Point Friday, May 18, 2012**

The day after the Prom has traditionally been designated for the Freshman/Sophomore Day at Cedar Point. It's their Prom, an opportunity to get together, on a school sponsored event, in a casual atmosphere and enjoy one of the great amusement parks. However, unlike the Prom, **ONLY SETON-LA SALLE STUDENTS ARE PERMITTED, NO GUESTS**. This year the Cedar Point trip is scheduled for **Friday, May 18, 2012**, a school holiday.

As with all school-sponsored events, students are subject to all rules and regulations of the school to ensure safety. Violations of school policy involving drugs, alcohol, weapons, etc., will be treated as if the offense took place at school. Additionally, students with outstanding tuition balances and /or unsatisfactory disciplinary records will be considered ineligible to attend. Any questions concerning eligibility should be directed to Mr. Zugates.

**COST:** \$90.00 per person. This fee covers the cost of the round-trip bus fare and ride-all-day admission ticket to Cedar Point. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.** Food and souvenirs are not included and will require students to carry cash.

**FORMS:** Signed Parent Permission Forms must accompany the payment in full. **RESERVATIONS ARE MADE ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS. PARTIALLY FILLED BUSES WILL BE CANCELED AND MONEY REFUNDED.**

**TIME:** The bus will depart the school parking lot at 6:00 am on the morning of Friday, May 18<sup>th</sup> and will return to Seton-La Salle at approximately midnight, late Friday evening. We will make stops for food on both trips to and from the park at some midpoint of the four-hour bus ride.

# Cedar Point Trip - Friday, May 18, 2012

**This information must be taken home to parents!!**

*There are 120 students who will be making the trip to Cedar Point and there are several points of interest:*

1. **Deposits are non-refundable.** Tickets for all reservations have already been purchased in order to obtain group rates and refunds are not possible.
2. **Reservations are not transferable.** If you are not attending the trip, you may not give your bus or park ticket to another student.
3. Any violation of school policies will be dealt with swiftly.
4. The buses will leave the Seton-La Salle High School parking lot promptly at 6:00 am with or without you, **RAIN OR SHINE.**
5. The \$90.00 fee includes transportation to and from Cedar Point and Ride-All-Day Admission to the park. Food and souvenirs are additional and students should bring whatever money they see necessary. The admission purchased is for the amusement park but not SOAK CITY, not the Challenge Park, not The Grand Prix and not Miniature Golf.
6. The bus will stop in the morning approximately half-way for breakfast and again half-way home for dinner at a fast food restaurant.
7. Arrangements will be made with chaperones and park security at Cedar Point in case of emergency. Cedar Point does not have a paging system. If an emergency arises, and you need, you may call Cedar Point at 1-419-626-0830 and leave a message at the Message Center for a student in the Seton-La Salle Group. Chaperones will make periodic checks at the Message Center. Mr. Zugates can be reached on his cell phone at 412-818-9464.
8. If you are unfamiliar with Cedar Point, it is similar to Kennywood but three times as large. There are water rides where one can get very wet. Lockers are available to rent if students wish to bring extra clothes or where personal items can be left for the day.
9. The buses will depart Cedar Point at 8:00 pm and, after stopping to eat on the way home, should arrive at Seton-La Salle at approximately midnight. **PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS AHEAD OF TIME TO PICK-UP STUDENTS AT MIDNIGHT. THE CHAPERONES WILL APPRECIATE NOT NEEDING TO WAIT FOR STUDENT RIDES TO ARRIVE.**
