Four Year Renewable Scholarships

J.L. Merrick Scholarship

A half-tuition scholarship awarded to two incoming Seton-La Salle freshmen based on academic achievement, standardized test scores, and the High School Placement Test scores. These awards are **renewable** provided the student maintains a 3.5 QPA and demonstrates the positive qualities of a Seton-La Salle student as outline in the SLS Student Handbook.

Edward Ryan Martin, Sr. Scholarship for Our Lady of Grace

A \$1500 award to an Our Lady of Grace parishioner and/or Our Lady of Grace graduate who displays Christian leadership, a generous spirit, and academic achievement. **Renewable** based an academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

RAY & GAIL KENNEDY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

This scholarship honors Mr. & Mrs. F. Raymond Kennedy who valued Catholic education, academic achievement, and their Brookline community. In addition to providing their three sons with a South Hills Catholic education, Gail worked at the school from 1967 to 1974.

The scholarship is a merit-based financial award for a student who resides in the Brookline community. It is a \$2600 award over four years (Year 1: \$500; Year 2: \$600; Year 3: \$700; Year 4: \$800) that is contingent on the student maintaining a 3.0 QPA and demonstrating the positive qualities of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

William C. Stout Scholarship for St. Bernard Students

A \$2000 award to a St. Bernard School graduate who displays academic achievement, service to his/her parish and/or community and will be attending Seton-La Salle Catholic High School. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook

Elizabeth Ann Seton Scholarship

Through the generosity of the “Women of Seton” of the former Elizabeth Seton High School, \$1000 is award to an incoming Seton-La Salle female freshman who demonstrates talent, merit, service to church and community and has an admiration for the examples of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

St. Francis Academy Alumnae Legacy Scholarship

Through the generosity of the St. Francis Academy Alumnae of the former St. Francis Academy, \$1000 is awarded to an incoming freshman woman who is sponsored by a SFA Alumnae Association member. This scholarship is designed to provide monetary assistance to a young woman who demonstrates academic achievement, service to church and community, financial need, and who has an admiration for the example of St. Francis of Assisi. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

Pittsburgh Foundation Fund for Saint Sylvester Students

A \$500 award to one St. Sylvester Grade School student attending Seton-La Salle Catholic High School who displays academic achievement, service to community, participates in sports and/or church related activities. **Renewable** based on continued academic achievement, service and involvement.

Edward Martin Ryan, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Two \$2500 awards to incoming Seton-La Salle freshmen who display a Christian attitude, academic achievement, serve their parish and/or community and demonstrate financial need. These awards are **renewable** provided the students maintain a minimum 3.0 QPA and demonstrate the positive qualities of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

Bishop Donald W. Wuerl Scholarship

A \$2000 award to one incoming Seton-La Salle freshman who exhibits academic achievement, demonstrates financial need, and the endorsement of the parish pastor. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

Anna Marie Catanzaro Scholarship

A \$2000 award to one incoming Seton-La Salle freshman who displays academic achievement, service to his/her church and/or community, and demonstrates financial need. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

The Gus Gillespie Scholarship

A \$1500 award to one incoming Seton-La Salle freshman from a Diocesan Catholic Elementary School who displays academic achievement, financial need and service to his/her school. **Renewable** based on academic criteria and the positive attributes of a of a Seton-La Salle student as outlined in the SLS Student Handbook.

Crossroads Foundation Scholarship

The Crossroads Foundation is a full support program available to students from St. Agnes, St. Benedict the More, Holy Rosary, St. James, Cardinal Wright, Good Shepherd and Bishop Leonard-St. Mary of the Mount Academy. Financial awards are determined by demonstrated financial need and available to students who wish to attend Seton-La Salle Catholic High School.

Non-Renewable Freshmen Scholarships

Richard R. Grandey Scholarship

A \$1500 award to an incoming Seton-La Salle freshman from a Diocesan Catholic Elementary School who displays above-average academic achievement, positive attitude toward school, kindness and community-mindedness.

Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill Scholarship

The Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill are proud to announce a \$1,000 scholarship to provide tuition assistance for an incoming freshman student attending Seton-La Salle High School. This scholarship is in honor of our foundress, Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, whose legacy to Catholic education continues today. Seton LaSalle is part of this rich heritage.

The Patrick Mackey Fund for St. Bernard Students

A \$500 award to two Bernard School graduates attending Seton-La Salle Catholic High School. Recipients are chosen based on teacher and principal recommendations.

Frank DeBor Scholarship for BRC Students

A \$500 awards to one Brookline Regional Catholic student continuing their Catholic education at a Diocesan High School, with grade school principal's recommendation.

Bishop Wuerl Junior Achievement Scholarship

A \$3000 award to ten students who attended Diocesan Grade Schools and participated in Junior Achievement.

Non-renewable Junior Scholarship

Anthony O'Toole-King O'Toole Honorary Scholarship

Applicant must be a 10th grader for the 2008-2009 academic school year at Seton-La Salle Catholic High School. Candidates will be evaluated on their academic achievement, service to the school and community, and demonstrated financial need. A scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded for their junior year at Seton-La Salle Catholic High School.

Annual Grants

Financial assistance is available for Seton-La Salle Catholic High School students unable to pay the full tuition amount. Financial awards are based upon an independent, objective assessment of need by the **Private School Aid Service (PSAS)**. **PSAS applications** are available from the diocese in January of the year the student wishes to apply for aid.

Bishop's Education Fund

Educational grants from this fund assist students in Catholic elementary and secondary schools such as Seton-La Salle in the Diocese of Pittsburgh.

Scholastic Opportunity Scholarship (SOS) Fund

Need-based grants are made available to Seton-La Salle students from the Diocese of Pittsburgh through the Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC) offered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Seton-La Salle Tuition Assistance Fund

Approximately \$200,000 is raised each year by alumni of **Seton-La Salle, Elizabeth Seton**, and **South Hills Catholic** as well as community friends. Monetary grants are awarded annually based on demonstrated financial need.
