Dear Parents,

In preparation for the 2011-12 ski season, this letter and the following forms are meant to inform you about the procedures, prices and rules governing ski club outings. In the past, the ski club has enjoyed tremendous success. We aim to provide students with a good skiing experience at a reasonable cost. Prices are based on significantly discounted group rates offered by resorts within a two hour radius. Friday ski trips will leave SLSHS by bus at 3 pm, with return to the school at about midnight. Monday "holiday" trips will leave SLSHS by bus at 7 am, with return to the school at about 8 pm.

Please be advised that **this document is a preliminary form requesting contact and medical information. Your child will be required to turn in an additional permission form for each trip** that they plan to attend. Permission forms will be available on Seton LaSalle's web page and in room 303 (Mrs. Pastor) two weeks prior to each trip. **Permission forms for the first planned trip (Monday, January 16) are also on the SLS web site, under the cover of this letter. Club Rules and Application forms must be handed in to Mrs. Pastor before students may sign up to attend a Club trip/event.**

If a trip is full (20+), and you decide to cancel after the Wednesday afternoon before a scheduled trip, you will not receive a refund.

If a trip is NOT full (<20) by the Wednesday afternoon before a scheduled trip, you will receive a refund or a credit for a future trip.

Permission forms and money are due *together* to Mrs. Pastor, NO LATER THAN the Wednesday afternoon before a scheduled trip. *No extensions will be granted.*

The following rules will apply, and will be strictly enforced, on all Ski Club trips:

- Every student must make arrangements to be picked up at school no later than 12:00 midnight.
- All rules in the Seton-LaSalle Student Handbook will apply to this school sponsored activity.
- There will be a ZERO TOLERANCE policy applied to any student caught with/using, DRUGS or ALCOHOL.
- Skiing & snowboarding are physical sports, and students will be held responsible for their own proper behavior.
- To travel and participate, students must be in attendance at school that day (if it is a school day).
- All reservations are on a FIRST come basis. We need a minimum of 20 ***lift ticket purchasing*** students per trip, or the trip will be cancelled.
- If students go up to Seven Springs with the group, they must also return with the group, unless written permission is received on the permission form.
- If your child is a "beginner" level skier or snowboarder, it is recommended that they opt to take a lesson (prices are listed on permission forms).
