

How we raise funds

Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs. Participants can receive up to a 90% tax credit on contributions to the program. For example, a \$5,000 contribution would result in a tax refund of \$4,500. This means an out-of-pocket cost of only \$500 for a \$5,000 donation.
