- 1. What dangers from foreign influence does Jay write about? How does the new Constitution address those concerns? (Articles 2-5)
- 2. What problems between the states was Hamilton concerned about? (Articles 6-8)
- 3. What were the most compelling arguments as to why the Articles of Confederation was insufficient to preserve the Union? (Articles 15-22)
- 4. In Federalist #10; According to Madison, what is the relationship between faction and liberty? How will the new Constitution address the inevitable faction?
- 5. Many scholars see Federalist #10 as the best explanation of how the Constitution works. Explain why.
- 6. In Federalist #70; According to Madison, what does a strong president provide to a representative democracy? Why does a weak executive create bad government? What is the most necessary quality of a President?
- 7. In Federalist #78; What three issues about the judiciary does Hamilton address? Why must the judiciary remain in office indefinitely?
- 8. In Federalist #85; List the four defects of the Constitution according to Hamilton. Why does Hamilton say the Constitution should be adopted despite its imperfections?
