



Chrome from Home

Seton LaSalle Catholic High School Flexible Instructional Days

On a Chrome from Home Day, SLS students will use their Chromebooks to complete class work and assignments on snow or other canceled school days. Students and teachers can take advantage of the 1:1 technology to maintain learning and instruction, even though they are not in the school building.

The following schedule will be used to facilitate a Chrome from Home day:

- **By 8:30 a.m. - Students will receive a Chrome from Home Day Daily Attendance (Google Form) email** from the principal to which they will need to respond to have their daily attendance taken. Students need to respond to this email by 9am to be considered on time and present for the day. If in need of help responding to the email, students should email Mrs. Martin (martinl@slshs.org).
- Students who do not respond on the form will be marked absent for the day; Students who are late responding will be marked Tardy for the day.
- **By 8:30 a.m. - Teachers will post assignments on their Google Classroom pages**, and some may send an email to their students with directions for completing the assignments. Many teachers will share assignments prior to 8:30 a.m., so students may begin checking their email as early as they like.
- **By 9am - Students must respond to the Daily Attendance email**, and check their teachers' Google Classroom pages and school email accounts for their assignments, and determine if they have any questions for their teachers. If in need of help, students should email their individual teachers.
- Assignments have a deadline - pay attention to that deadline and make sure all work is submitted on time
- Teachers will be available online throughout the day to address student questions via email. If students encounter problems and questions with their assignments and cannot complete the assignments, they should email their teachers. The email should inform the teachers of the issues they are experiencing. Students will remain responsible for completing the assignments according to their teachers' assignment deadline expectations but will be provided the opportunity to ask the teachers questions the following day in class and extra time to finish the assignments if appropriate. Student communication with individual teachers is essential.

For unexpected cancellations (usually weather related), we will identify the Chrome from Home Day via phone, text, and email directly to families and students. Local news stations may not provide a specific wording option to indicate Chrome from Home or Flexible Instructional Days. Students should remember to take their Chromebooks home each night in the event that school is canceled the next day(s). We will have no more than two (2) consecutive Chrome from Home Days in any cancellation period.
