Recipients will be determined by a review of their application (see attached) and by verified financial need through FACTS Management.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be enrolled at Seton LaSalle Catholic High School for 2018-19
- Meet all school academic eligibility requirements
- Have a clean discipline record
- Demonstrate leadership abilities
- Show verified financial need determined by FACTS Management

To qualify, applicant must:

- Submit a completed application form
- Submit a copy of student's transcripts
- Submit a letter/essay (see application for details)
- Submit two letters of recommendations, including one from a current teacher or School Principal
